## HOLDEN COLORADO ROX CASE STUDY

### Successful roadshow delivered through solid commitment and planning.

The Holden New Zealand brand requires little introduction to the majority of Kiwis, the first Holden assembled in New Zealand was back in 1957 and their range of cars, utes and SUV's have been a firm favourite for car enthusiasts since.

Marc Warr, former National Marketing Manager for Holden New Zealand worked with Hamish and the team at X-Site on countless events throughout his 10+ year tenure with the company.

At the conclusion of the Fieldays Marc put his trust in Hamish and his team to deliver and set up the Colorado ROX at events and Holden branches around the country. The Colorado ROX towed an impressive custom built service trailer which was actually a portable BBQ and held various other event materials such as bean bags and tables.
